Wendy Bailye is an award winning Australian contemporary felt artisan and designer. Working with an eclectic mix of wool fibers, fabrics, silks, threads and recycled materials, Wendy produces fibre rich artworks and wearables. Each piece tells a story. Her main love is of experimental surface texture and design incorporating different fabrics and fibres to make an interesting whole. She produces original, hand-felted textile artworks – home wares, wall art and wearables. The making of hand-made wool felt is an ancient technique that has developed into a very advanced contemporary art form including the use of a wide variety of modern materials in the process. Felt making is a process of transformation, combining fabrics and fibres with great alchemy into a pleasing finished product.
